2023 NORTHEAST IOWA BASEBALL LEAGUE RULE AMENDMENTS

All Rules and Regulations found in the 2023 National Federation of State High School Associations Rule Book will be followed:

MAJORS DIVISION: (players who completed 6th & 7th grade are eligible to play)

- 1. Pitching distance will be 50-54 feet, 70-80 feet between bases.
 - a. The mound and base length can adjust within range if the field is capable.
- 2. No balk is to be called. The result is a dead ball, no play, and everyone returns.
 - a. Coaches are encouraged to instruct players on the basics of pitching within regulation balk rules to prevent advantage play and game length.
 - b. Umpires are encouraged to call balks when a clear advantage is achieved with the balk. For example, an illegal motion is made that aids in assisting in picking off a baserunner.
- 3. Base runners can lead off.
- 4. Dropped 3rd strike **rule** is played.
- 5. Base runners can steal any base at any time.
- 6. On-deck circles are allowed within the field boundary.
 - a. On-Deck Batter must be on the same side of the field as the batter in the box
- 7. No metal or steel spikes will be allowed.
- 8. Games will consist of 5 innings. 10-run rule after 3 ½ for the home team or four innings for the visitor. (Games can be shortened if agreed upon by both team coaches before the game begins)
- 9. Bat barrels must be BB Core or USSSA Stamped to be eligible for play.
 - a. Any 2 5/8" is allowed. No 2 3/4".
- 10. Home is open until a lead of 5 runs or more is obtained at the end of the inning; then, it will be closed. The home is re-opened if the run gap is under five runs.
- 11. If up by ten runs or more, the leading team is limited to 5 runs per inning until the gap narrows. This applies to the first three innings only.
- 12. No new inning can start after 75 Minutes.

Pitching Rules:

- 1. If only pitching one inning, a pitcher can pitch on consecutive days
 - a. If a pitcher throws to more than one batter in an inning, the inning counts toward their scheduled rest days
- 2. less than four innings = 1 calendar days rest, four innings or more = 3 calendar days rest
- 3. Six innings maximum per day (includes 2nd game of doubleheader)
- 4. A player removed after pitching cannot return to pitch in the same game. A pitcher can pitch in 2nd game of a doubleheader until six inning maximum is reached.
- 5. Pitching mounds are **highly encouraged** for 6/7th grades.

MINORS DIVISION (players who completed 4th^d & 5th grades)

All of the Rules listed for the Majors Division will apply to this division except for the following amendments.

- 1. Each team may score a maximum of 5 runs per inning except for the last inning of a game which will have open scoring. Each game will be 5 innings.
- 2. No new inning will begin after 1 hour and 15 minutes from the beginning of the game.
- 3. All players will play defensively a minimum of 2 innings and bat at least once per game unless the game is shortened for any reason.
- 4. If a team has only 8 players available there is no out when the 9th player would be up to bat. Bat all players but field 9.
- 5. Dropped 3rd strike is always an out.
- 6. Pitching distance will be 46'. The base distance will be 65-70 feet.
- 7. No on-deck circles are allowed within the field boundary.
- 8. Deadball Once the ball has returned to the pitcher and the pitcher has control of the ball it is considered a dead ball and the play ends. Runners can no longer advance.
- 9. Home is closed unless a play on a base is attempted.
- 10. No stealing unless it is a passed ball. A Passed ball is defined as the catcher has to move to get the ball outside of the frame of their body.

Pitching Rules:

- 1. If only pitching one inning a pitcher can pitch on consecutive days
 - a. If a pitcher throws to more than one batter in an inning, the inning counts toward their scheduled rest days
- 2. less than 4 innings = 1 calendar days rest, 4 innings or more = 3 calendar days rest
- 3. Six innings maximum per day (includes 2nd game of doubleheader)
- 4. A player removed after pitching cannot return to pitch in the same game. A pitcher can pitch in 2nd game of a doubleheader until six inning maximum is reached.
- 5. Pitching mounds are not required.

EXTRA INNING RULES:

The WU Swing-Off Rule will play extra innings.

- a. Swing-Off: One hitter on each team will be allowed three swings on five pitches from their coach or another player from the front of the mound
 - Of those three swings, whichever hitter hits the ball the furthest in the field of play, in the air, will be determined the game's winner by the umpires roaming the field.
 - ii. If a player does not make contact on a swing, it still counts as a swing
 - iii. If a player doesn't use three swings in the five pitches, he will not be awarded any extra chances.

PITCHING MACHINE/ Coach Pitch LEAGUE: (players who completed 2nd & 3rd grades)

- 1. The team can be mixed with boy and girl players.
- 2. The Ultimate Pitching Machine or Coach Pitching will be used in games with a 35-foot distance. Coaches pitch to their team.
- 3. The consecutive batting order will be used with all players on the bench.
- 4. Each ½ inning will consist of once through the entire team batting order, three outs, or 6 runs.
- 5. 6 pitches per batter maximum **NO EXCEPTIONS** (Each coach will pitch to their own team)
- 6. No stealing
- 7. Games will consist of 5 innings (No new inning will begin after 1 hour and 20 minutes from the beginning of the game.)
- 8. All players must play a minimum of 2 innings defensively.
- 9. Must use regular baseballs, not the balls used in t-ball.
- 10. Teams with both boys and girls can decide if they want to use baseballs or softballs. The coaches must agree.

There are <u>no</u> home-field rules. Follow the Rule Book and League Amendments. Failure to do so could result in ineligibility for the league tournament.
